# **BLOCK ASSEMBLY: Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS**

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, iron the rough side of fusible web product to the wrong side of the (5) A fussy cut panel motifs. Let cool, then trim to border of each motif. Fuse each small motif to B 12-1/2" squares and fuse the large motif to the B 20-1/2" x 24-1/2" rectangle to create BLOCKS 1A, 1B, 1C, 1D and 1E. Machine stitch around appliques if desired.



# BLOCK ASSEMBLY (continued):

# Refer to BLOCK DIAGRAMS

- Sew (1) C 4-1/2" square, (2) D 4-1/2" squares, and (4) E 4-1/2" squares into rows as shown. Then sew rows together to create BLOCK 2A. Square to 12-1/2", make (6)
- 3. Repeat step 2 using pieces indicated in diagrams to create BLOCKS 2B, 2C and 2D. Square all to 12-1/2", make number indicated.
- Sew (2) D 4-1/2" squares, (1) E 4-1/2" square, (2) F 4-1/2" squares, and (1) G 4-1/2" squares together, then sew to top of BLOCK 1E.



# QUILT ASSEMBLY:

Refer to QUILT DIAGRAM for proper placement and rotation.

Sew BLOCKS together into rows.

ROW 1: 1A-2A-2B-2C-2D

ROW 2: 2A-2B-2C-1B-2A

ROW 3: 2B-1C-2D-2A-2B

ROW 4: Sew (1) BLOCK 2C, (1) BLOCK 2A and (2) BLOCK 2D together, then sew to left side of BLOCK 1E. Sew (1) BLOCK 2C and (1) BLOCK 2D together and sew to right side of BLOCK 1E.

ROW 5: 2A-2B-2C-2D-1D

Sew rows together.

# FINISHING:

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with M fabric.
